

**UNDERHILL EXPANDS MICROEASE LOW VOLUME**  
**LINE WITH “LARGE AREA” IRRIGATION KIT**

Underhill expands the MicroEase line with the introduction of a pre-packaged Large Area Micro-Irrigation Kit.

MicroEase Large Area Kits (ME-SS-PK) save installation time because all necessary components for a complete low volume system are included in the package. The Large Area Kit is designed for planting beds or other limited areas around clubhouses or other facilities.

Underhill's Large-Area Kit (ME-SS-PK) includes (25) 6-inch spikes, each featuring an 8-stream pattern with adjustable flow and radius. Flow adjusts up to 24 gph (or .40 gpm) and the radius adjusts from 0 to 14 feet.

Spikes are typically installed 3 to 6 feet apart. The Large Area Kit has a precipitation rate of 1.0" / hour, depending on adjustment and spacing.

To optimize operation, Underhill recommends that MicroEase irrigation lines connect directly to a dedicated sprinkler system valve or faucet. The Large Area Kit is designed to run approximately six minutes per day, or during summer months in two six-minute cycles each day.

Each complete MicroEase Large Area Kit includes: (25) 6-inch spikes with adjustable spray nozzle; faucet connector; 50 feet of 5/8" main line supply tubing; 50 feet of 1/4" lateral supply tubing; snap-on faucet adapter; snap-on filter; ratchet clamp; (2) compression hose end caps; (10) goof plugs; 5/8" compression elbow; 5/8" compression tee; key punch, and instructions and watering guide in English and Spanish.
